



The 12-member Board of Governors of the Notary Foundation of BC is comprised of:

- eight members of the Board of Directors of The Society of Notaries Public of BC;
- one representative from the Attorney General's office in Victoria;
- two Directors-at-Large, appointed by the Attorney General; and
- the Executive Officer.

The eight members from The Society are elected by the Directors of The Society from among their ranks, for a three-year period.

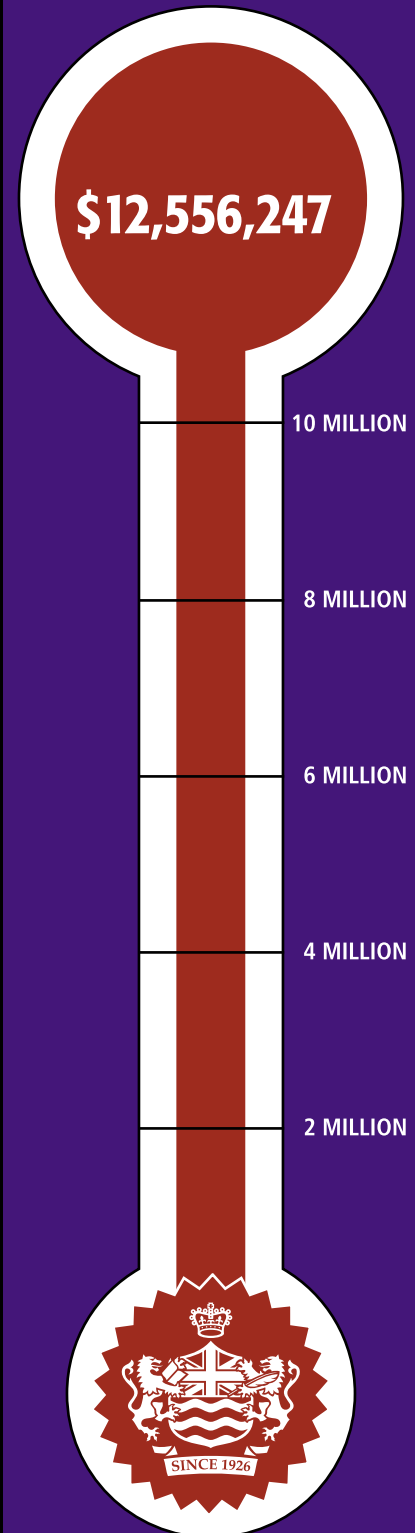

The Governors of the Foundation have the responsibility of guiding the Foundation in its mandate to disperse the funds generated by interest on Notaries' Trust Accounts for the following purposes.

3. Legal aid
4. Education and continuing education for Notaries and applicants who have enrolled to become BC Notaries
5. Establishing, operating, and maintaining law libraries in BC
6. Contributions to the special fund established under the *Notaries Act of BC*
