PETITION TO THE COURT

This proceeding has been started by the petitioner(s) for the relief set out in Part 1 below.

If you intend to respond to this petition, you or your lawyer must

- (a) file a response to petition in Form 67 in the above-named registry of this court within the time for response to petition described below, and
- (b) serve on the petitioner(s)
 - (i) 2 copies of the filed response to petition, and
 - (ii) 2 copies of each filed affidavit on which you intend to rely at the hearing.

Orders, including orders granting the relief claimed, may be made against you, without any further notice to you, if you fail to file the response to petition within the time for response.

Time for response to petition

A response to petition must be filed and served on the petitioner(s),

- (a) if you reside anywhere within Canada, within 21 days after that service,
- (b) if you reside in the United States of America, within 35 days after that service,
- (c) if you reside elsewhere, within 49 days after that service, or
- (d) if the time for response has been set by order of the court, within that time.

CLAIM OF THE PETITIONERS

Part 1: ORDER(S) SOUGHT

1. The petitioners be examined in the duties of a Notary Public within one year of the pronouncement of this Order at such time and place as shall be appointed by the Society of Notaries Public of British Columbia (the "Society").

2. If any of the petitioners are found not qualified on examination, but have, in the judgment of the Society, achieved distinction on such examination sufficient to merit re-examination, those petitioners be re-examined in the duties of a Notary Public at such time and place as shall be appointed by the Society.
3. If any of the petitioners are found to be qualified on such examination or re-examination, then that petitioner shall be enrolled as a member of the Society pursuant to section 6 of the *Notaries Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 334.

Part 2: FACTUAL BASIS

1. The petitioners wish to be examined in the duties of a Notary Public and, if found qualified on such examination, to be enrolled as members of the Society.
2. The petitioners are Canadian citizens or permanent residents of Canada.
3. The petitioners have met the Society's requirements to apply for enrollment.
4. The petitioners have passed the preparatory course for Notarial Candidates.

Part 3: LEGAL BASIS

1. Sections 5 and 6 of the *Notaries Act*, R.S.B.C. 1996, c. 334.
